| MOROCCO | TOTAL MAROC | Sales' volume down 13% in H1 2020

In H1 2020, sales' volume of Total Maroc declined by 13.3% to 747KT. The Group's consolidated revenue fell by 26.5% in H1 2020 to MAD 4,433 Mn.

MOROCCO | DELTA HOLDING | Consolidated revenue down 16% in H1 2020

At the end of H1 2020, Delta Holding's consolidated revenue stood at MAD 1,134 Mn, down 16.1% compared to the same period of the previous year.

MOROCCO | LESIEUR CRISTAL | Consolidated revenue up 6% in H1 2020

In Q2 2020, Lesieur Cristal's revenue increased by 16.6% to reach MAD 1,089 Mn. In this context, the Group's consolidated revenue jumped by 6.4% to MAD 2,067 Mn in H1 2020.

MOROCCO | SBM | Consolidated revenue down 11% in H1 2020

In H1 2020, SBM's consolidated revenue shows a decrease of 10.6% to MAD 877 Mn. According to the company's press release, the severe and prolonged impact on the entire economy as well as the uncertainty over the situation evolution would result in a deterioration in SBM's results as of June 30 as well as on the FY 2020.

| MOROCCO | ADDOHA | Consolidated revenue down 79% in H1 2020

In H1 2020, Addoha consolidated revenue fell by 79.2% to MAD 420 Mn. In addition, the Group' pre-sales declined by 16.7% to 3,578 units.

| MOROCCO | ALLIANCES | Consolidated revenue down 37% in H1 2020

At the end of June 2020, Alliances' revenue fell by 37% to MAD 668 Mn against MAD 1,054 Mn during the same period of the previous year.

| MOROCCO | EQDOM | NBI down 8% in H1 2020

In H1 2020, Eqdom's Net Banking Income amounted to MAD 256 Mn, down 7.9% compared to the same period of the previous year.

MOROCCO ATLANTA Consolidated revenue up 5% in H1 2020

At the end of June 2020, Atlanta's revenue increased by 5.3% compared to the same period of the previous year to reach MAD 2,888 Mn.

MOROCCO | JET CONTRACTORS | Consolidated revenue down 19% in H1 2020

At the end of June 2020, Jet Contractors recorded a turnover of MAD 664 Mn against MAD 822 Mn during the first six months of the previous year, i.e. a decrease of 19.2%. The Group announced that its financial performance in 2020 will be significantly lower compared to the previous year.

In H1 2020, Salafin's Net Banking Income stood at MAD 182.9 Mn, showing a decrease of 17.4% compared to the same period of the previous year.

MOROCCO AGMA Consolidated revenue down 2% in H1 2020

In H1 2020, AGMA posted a revenue of MAD 68.3 Mn against MAD 70.0 Mn during the first six months of the previous year, i.e. a decrease of 2.4%.

In a press release, Balima expects a 25% drop in its net income at MAD 5.5 Mn in H1 2020 due to the combined effect of the increase in doubtful receivables and the decrease in non-recurring income compared to 2019.
