| MOROCCO | AKDITAL | Signing of two partnership agreements with UM6P

Akdital has signed two partnership agreements with UM6P (Université Mohammed VI Polytechnique), within the framework of the "Health Care City" of Benguerir. | BURKINA FASO | FOREIGN TRADE | A trade deficit of FCFA -640 Bn in 2022

According to the National Institute of Statistics and Demography (INSD), Burkina Faso's imports amounted to FCFA 3,439.5 Bn in 2022, up 34.1% compared to the previous year. Meanwhile, exports rose by 0.2% to FCFA 2,799.1 Bn during the same period. In this context, the trade balance displays a deficit of FCFA -640.4 Bn in 2022 against a surplus of FCFA 230.1 Bn in 2021.
